### **RESTRICTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:**

(All vendors and anyone having a booth at Yampa River Festival)

1. Vendors may submit vendor application form, payment, and necessary documentation the day of the events, June 6th, as long as contact has been made ahead of time.

2. Be prepared to be in the park for set up as early as 8am on Saturday, June 6th. We will be directing each vendor to their designated spot for setup at that time. The attached map is for reference only.

3. Vendors must break-down, pack-up and leave the event grounds according to the City of Steamboat Springs instructions. The festival will be completed at approximately 6pm on Saturday, June 6th.

4. Vendors must be prepared for rain, snow, or shine (Easy-up tents are recommended)

5. There is LIMITED electricity available at the park. If you need a generator, approval of your booth is on a case-by-case basis.

6. Vendors must abide by park restrictions – including location of vehicles and waste management guidelines.

7. Vendors must pay sales tax to the state of Colorado to benefit the City of Steamboat Springs; Appropriate paperwork must be submitted with vending application.

8. Vendors will provide an estimate of sales to festival organizers after the event by July 6th, 2020.
