Put-ins and takeouts: Due to limited parking, Friends of the Yampa encourages getting picked up and dropped off at the put-ins and takeouts for all events.

Event parking: The city of Steamboat Springs has a [free bus system](#). FOTY highly recommends taking the bus to the bus stop right outside of the Bud Werner Memorial Library on 13th Street. There is parking at the following locations:

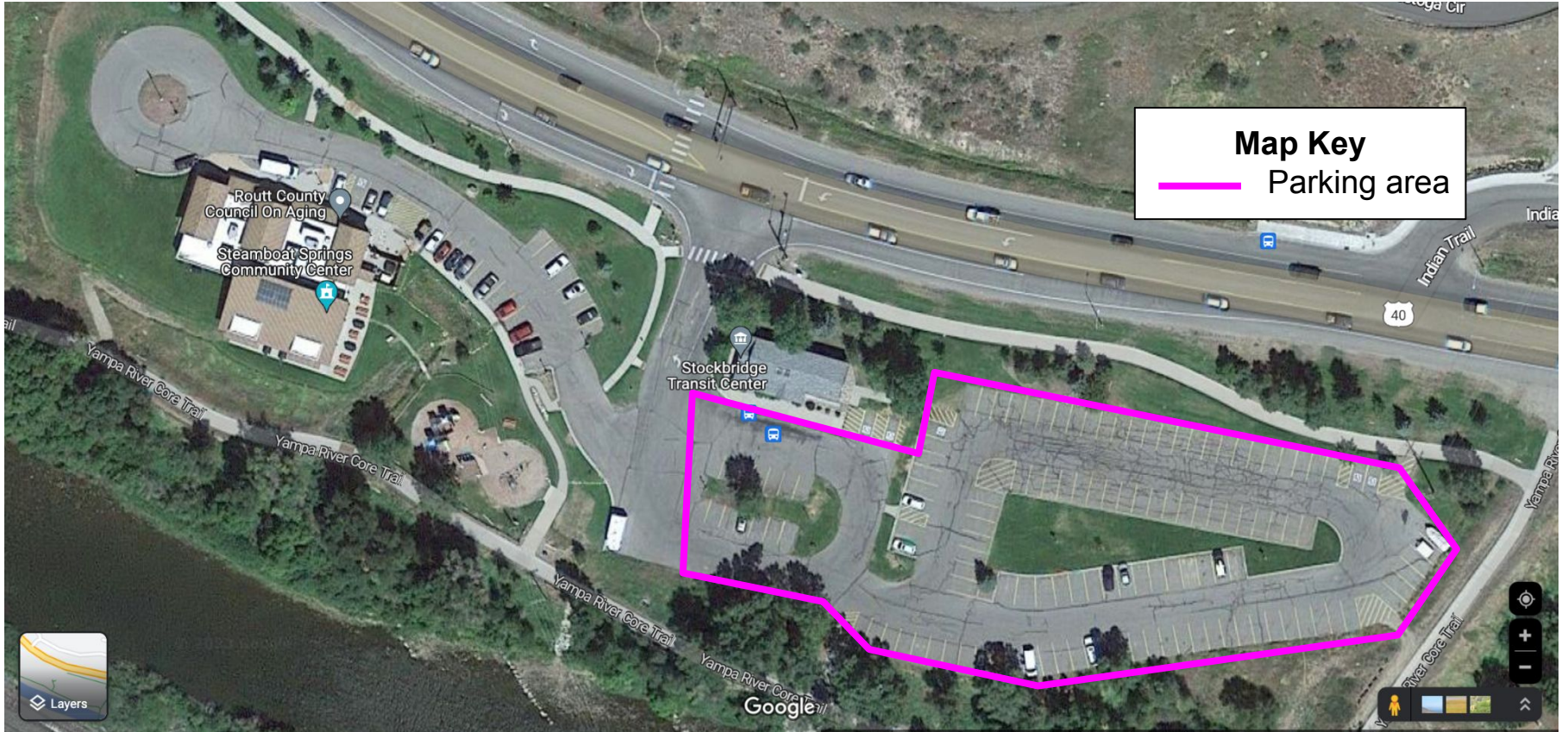
- Fetcher Pond

Walking and biking: Steamboat Springs has a trail that leads users directly to Yampa River Festival. Take the [Yampa River Core Trail](#) to events.

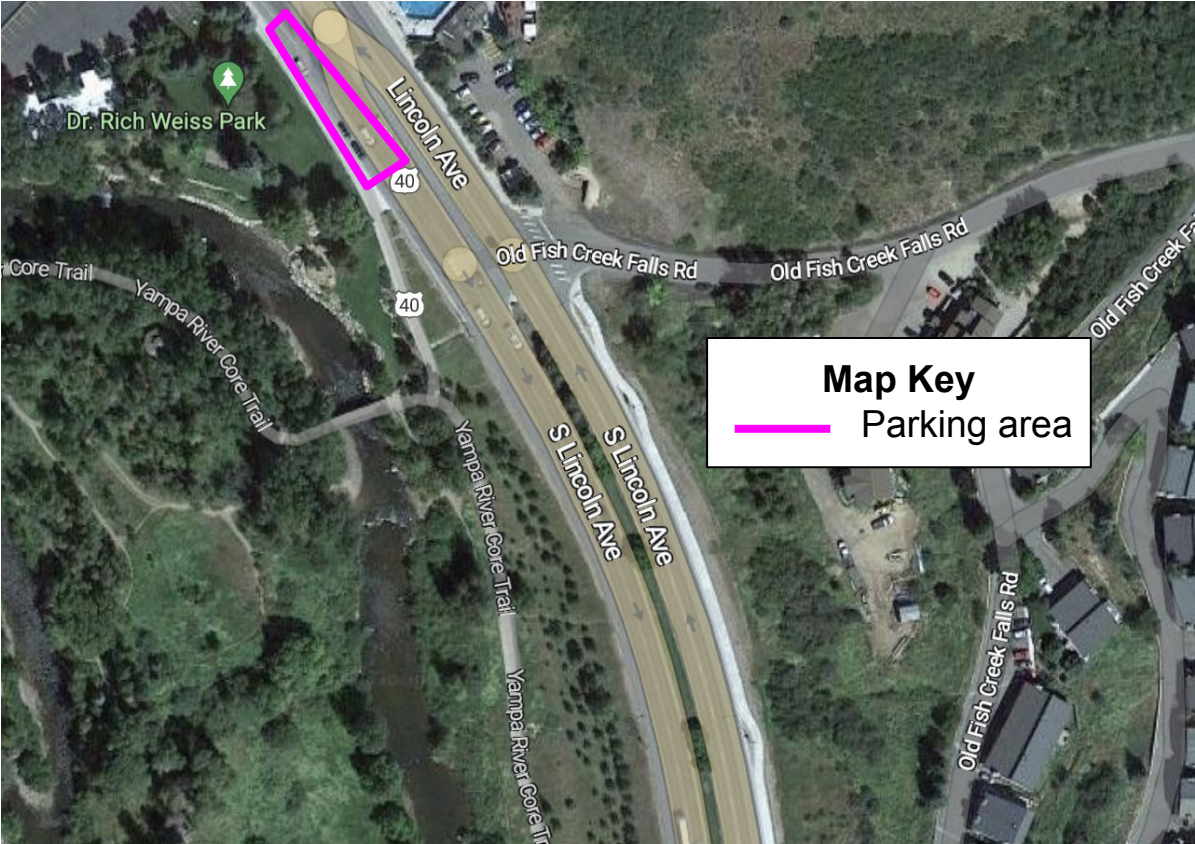

Stockbridge Transit Center, 1505 Lincoln Ave, Steamboat Springs

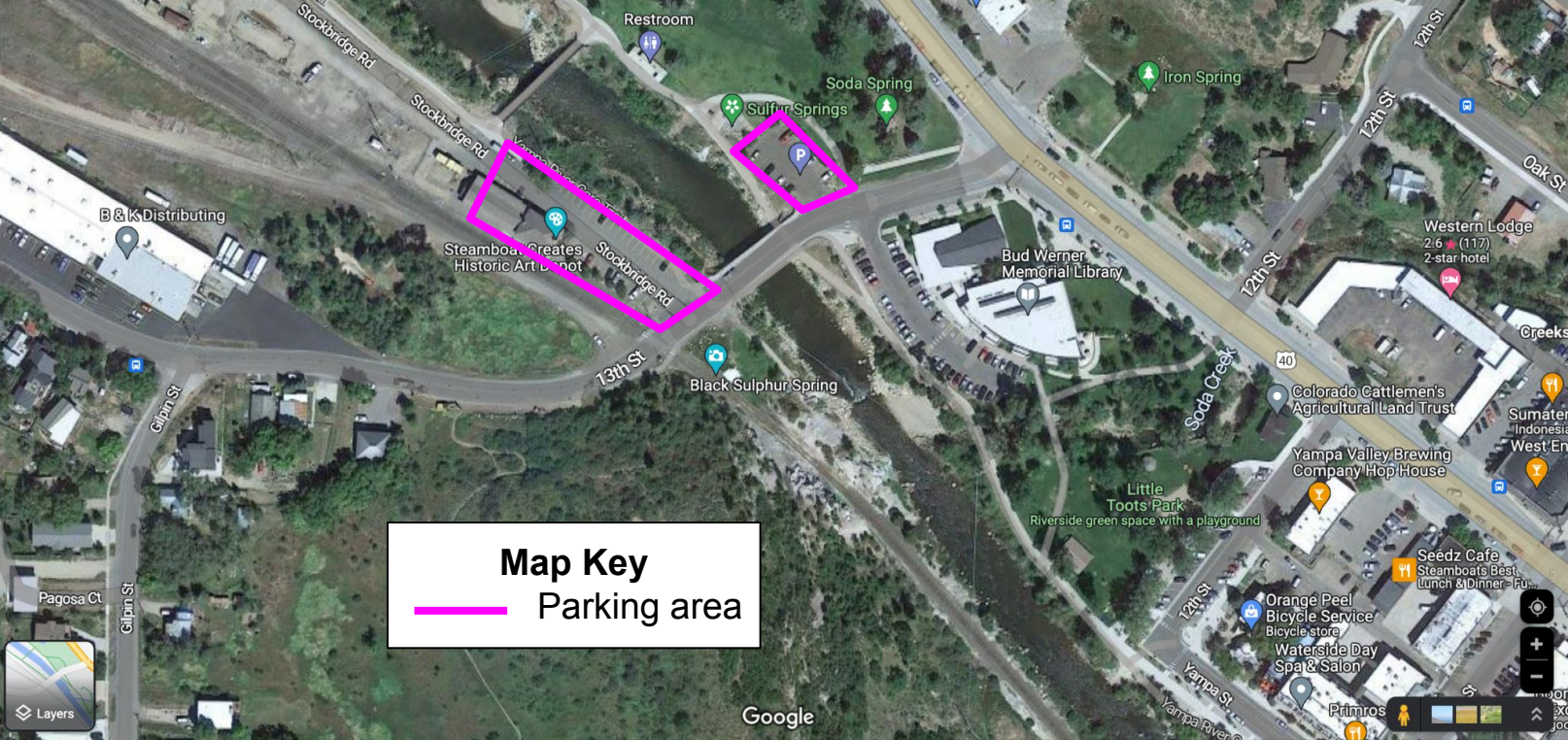


Dr. Rich Weiss Park, 125 Lincoln Ave, Steamboat Springs



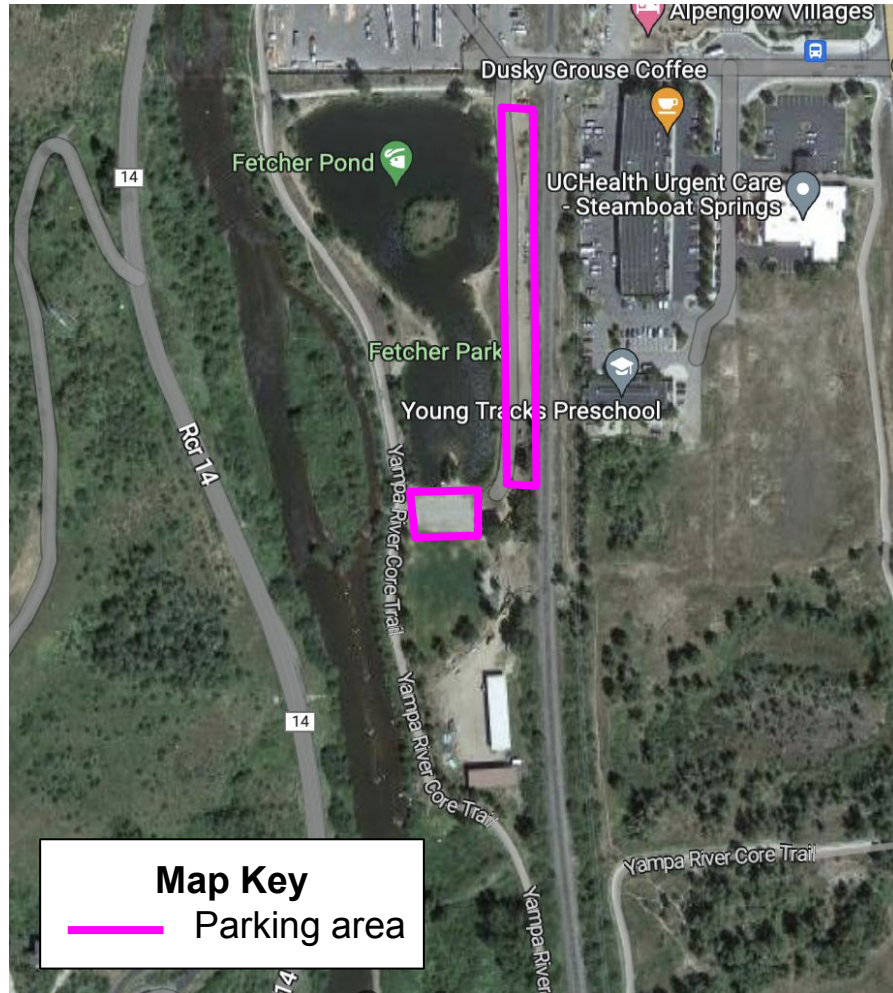
Parking is limited along Lincoln Avenue. Be sure to park inside of the white lines.

Sulfur Springs, 13th Street

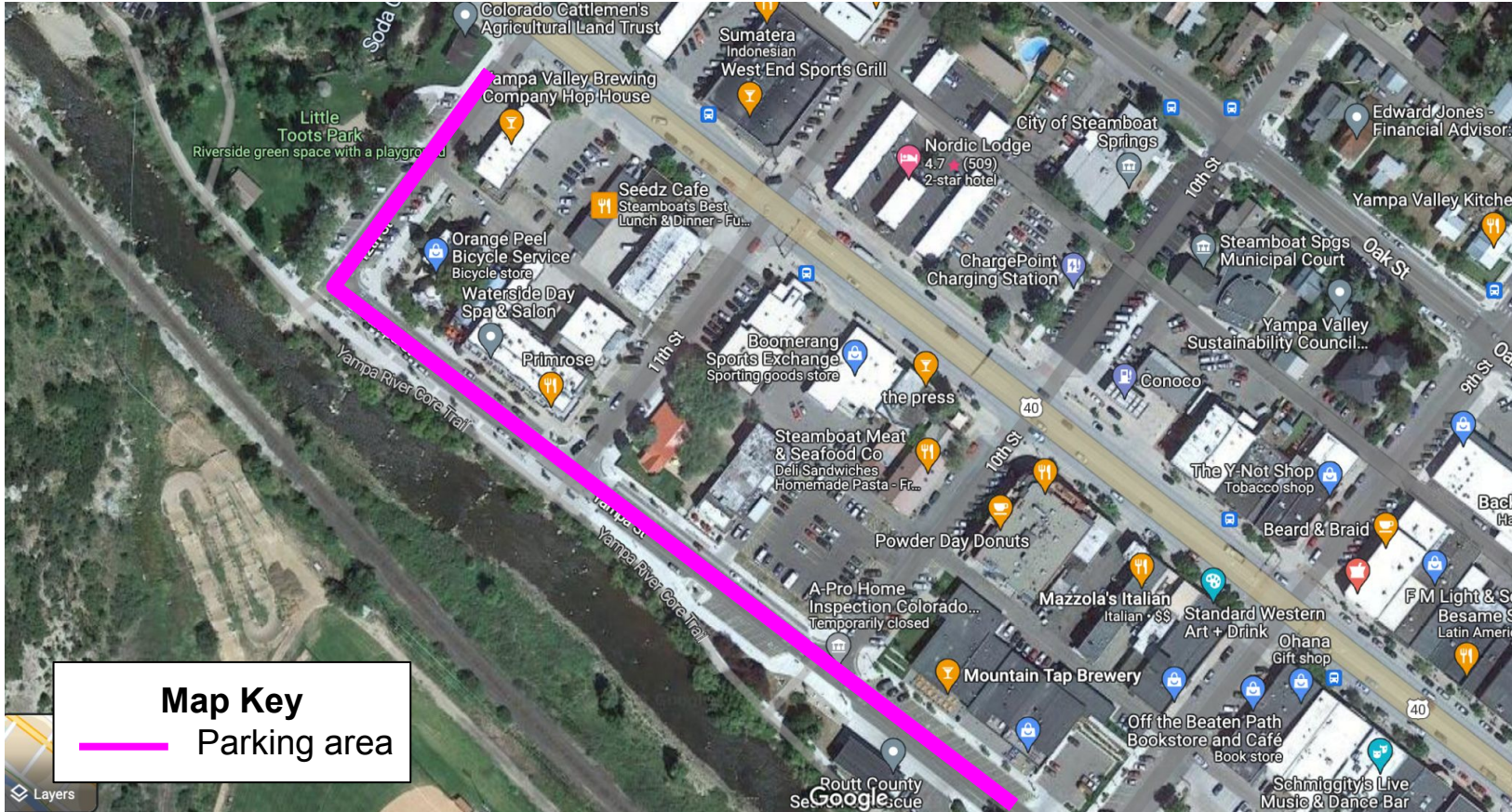


Fetcher Park,
