


Established in 1981, we have a long standing

history of working to develop support for a healthy Yampa River that supports a vibrant, diverse economy and is accessible for all.

We organize river cleanups; work to provide access to the river; hold discussions about the Yampa's important and rare attributes; fund

and help build river habitats and river features for a variety of uses; and participate in a local, regional and national policy efforts and campaigns. Our annual Yampa River Festival is a mainstay and a big part of our spring efforts and then in the fall we hold our annual fundraiser, the Big Snow Bash. Every May/June we partner with American Rivers

and OARS to host an annual Yampa River Awareness
Project float trip down the
Yampa Canyon. We engage
with stakeholders and work
to bridge the gap between
recreation and agriculture.
Our Youth River Camps help
inspire youth to love and
Respect the Yampa.

Today, the Yampa River and its tributaries remain a model of a healthy river system, not only here in Northwest Colorado but in the entire Colorado River Basin and the Western U.S.

We hired a new position, Conservation Program Manager, to help us expand our ability to help and protect the Yampa, and it is our next step of our growth as a watershed organization. We collaborated with the City of Steamboat Springs to run the River Ambassador program and educate the public on how they can have fun and float responsibly; coinciding with this effort we also released the Know Before You Go Dashboard, so all of you Yampa River floaters and visitors can prepare before leaving your home and be ready to hit the river in a safe manner. Our ability to celebrate the successes of 2023 are because of the support from our community of river lovers and donors. Thank you for getting us this far!

FOTY GOALS FOR 2024

Please take a look in our annual report for all of the program and projects we helped lead or partner with — 2023 was a year of growth and 2024 is looking to be the same.


We have created a new program called the Yampa River Stewardship Program with a collaborative group of nonprofits to provide a resource in river and water management to water users and land owners adjacent to the river. This program will provide learning workshops, materials, and outreach events, and will help bring projects forward with support so people are not left without help in getting infrastructure and river health improvements completed. With Community Agriculture Alliance moving its location, we plan on expanding our space to offer a river center for the community and visitors to learn all about the Yampa. We will hold our second year of Dinosaur National Monument River Camp for high school students, a free offering for Yampa Valley youth. We plan on hiring two more staff members to expand our ability to run new and existing programs. Our recreational education is growing with our expanded Know Before You Go Dashboard, a must use for all Yampa River recreators; our partnership with the City of Steamboat Springs to run the River Ambassador program; and our middle school Youth River Camps in collaboration with Colorado Mountain College. With our increase in staff, we will be able to be more present at watershed health planning initiatives to get ahead of decision-making that may impact the Yampa Basin. We will be releasing the Steamboat Springs segment of our Yampa River Scorecard Project, so stay tuned in early 2024, and will be moving on to assess the upper parts of the Yampa this year.

I appreciate you all for staying up to date with our progress, as well as supporting our work. Thank you for respecting and loving the Yampa!

2023 PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT






<< YAMPA RIVER SCORECARD PROJECT

The Scorecard Project is a long-term river health monitoring and evaluation program for the Yampa River Basin that rates the overall condition of different segments of the Yampa River and articulates results through a "scorecard." A program like this has yet to exist in the basin. Data collected for the Middle Segment of the Yampa River was analyzed and was released in 2023. Also in 2023, data was collected in the segment from Stagecoach Reservoir to Hayden Pump Station of the Yampa River, which will be released early 2024.

OUTSTANDING WATERS >>

In 2022, Friends of the Yampa started water sampling for Outstanding Waters designation and continued into 2023. Many of Colorado's headwaters streams provide high-quality water that contributes to the overall health and resilience of rivers in the region and by extension the health of the communities, ecosystems, and economies connected to it. OW is a designation awarded to such reaches of streams, rivers, or other bodies of water with high water quality and exceptional recreational or ecological significance. For the local endeavor, FOTY had help from 7 total volunteers to sample 13 sites on 28 sampling days in ALL weather totaling over 300 hours!



2023 PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT



<< YOUTH RIVER CAMPS

Youth from grades 7-9 attended a four-day camp on the river in Steamboat Springs, Yampa River State Park, and Craig. The goal of the program is to empower youth to travel safely in whitewater river conditions while falling in love with one of the most important resources here in the Yampa Valley. Friends of the Yampa teamed up with Yampatika to add additional science-based learning. FOTY also partnered with Colorado Mountain College Steamboat with support from Upper Yampa Water Conservancy District and Dinosaur National Monument. Our 2023 camp season got 50 kids on the river and awarded over \$5,000 in scholarships.

YAMPA RIVER CLEANUPS >>

In its eighth year, Friends of the Yampa partnered with the City of Steamboat Springs and Storm Peak Brewing Co. to host a river cleanup in Steamboat. We also teamed up with the City of Craig and Yampa Valley Brewing Co. for a cleanup in Craig! Volunteers spanned

15 different sections of the river in Steamboat and three boat access ramps in Moffat County. Volunteers and staff members celebrated with lunch and beverages after working in the heat.

<<43rd YAMPA RIVER FESTIVAL

The flagship event of Friends of the Yampa, the Yampa River Festival, is a true hometown celebration of the Yampa River. The festival that ran from June 2-4 is the biggest river event of the year, bringing droves of locals and visitors to watch people play in Charlie's Hole in downtown Steamboat and more! In addition to the action, there are booths set up to help educate attendees about the nonprofits and river groups in the valley.

The Fish Creek Kayak Race was held in spirit of our friend and previous board member, Adam Mayo, and the Downriver Raft Race was held in honor of our friend, Drew Hyde.

YAMPA RIVER AWARENESS PROJECT >>

YRAP, organized by Friends of the Yampa and American Rivers, rallies local, state, national, and international organizations, businesses and individuals to realize the unique natural and recreational values of the Yampa. Each year has a unique list of participants and each year has a different feel to the trip. The 2023 roster included leaders from Great Outdoors Colorado, Colorado River District, Dinosaur National Monument, Colorado Department of Natural Resources, Denver Water, Upper Colorado River Commission, Upper Colorado River Endangered Fish Recovery Program and more!


Plus for Yampa Valley Gives Day we raised a total of \$15,906 by 118 donors!

Youth from grades 9-12 attended a four-day camp on the Green River in Dinosaur National Monument in August 2023. Campers had the opportunity to participate in citizen science alongside biologists and experts. Colorado Mountain College Steamboat and Dinosaur National Monument were crucial to making the camp happen! Thanks to our generous supporters, we were able to offer camps completely free of charge.

<<YAMPA RIVER FUND

In 2023, the first full year of management by the Friends of the Yampa, the Yampa River Fund Endowment exceeded \$5 million and distributed \$166,141 to four projects. The largest contributors to the endowment were the Steamboat Ski Resort (\$100,000) and the City of Steamboat Springs, (\$25,000) but there were numerous individual donors, businesses, and foundations that contributed to the growth of the fund this year. In addition, we received dedicated funds for the administration of the

fund from Backdoor Sports, Big Agnes and several individual donors who have helped ensure we are able to carry out the work needed to manage and oversee the actions of the River Fund. The Greene Family Fund gave \$50,000 direct to projects as well.




- 2023 Yampa River Environmental Releases Program Colorado Water Trust: \$89,891

- Norvell Infrastructure Improvements \$11,250: Community Agriculture Alliance






